

## The 2012 PQ President's "Crayon" Challenge

This challenge is open to all PQ members who want to create a small wall hanging using three Crayon colors that match the initials of your name. So get your children or grandchildren's crayons out and begin the challenge. Here are some guidelines for this challenge.

1. The challenge starts with selecting 3 crayons with names that start with the same letter as each initial in your first, middle, and last name. Please use the English names on the crayons. You can use your middle name or maiden name. The letters **k, q, u, x, z** don't have crayon names that begin with these letters. If your name begins with one of these letters use the **second** letter in your name to choose the crayon color.\* For example:

Teri **D**ee **R**oberts – timberwolf, dandelion, red

**K**Aren **M**ary **W**illiams – apricot, magenta, wild strawberry

2. Select fabrics that match as closely as possible in color, shade, and tone to the colors of the crayons. The color of the crayon is not the wrapper – it is the color of the crayon wax when colored on paper.
3. The wall hanging top must be made of at least 60% of the 3 crayon colors. Please use these colors on the top of the small wall hanging.
4. 1 to 3 in additional fabric colors may be added.
5. The design may be your original design, design from a book, or a pattern.
6. The wall hanging can be square, oblong, round, a hexagon, or any other shape as long as the perimeter (total of all of the outside edges) falls within a minimum 60 of inches and maximum of 100 inches.
7. The wall hanging may be pieced, appliquéd, paper pieced or any combination of these techniques.
8. The wall hanging should be completed with quilting and binding.

Each finished wall hanging will be displayed at the May 2012 PQ party. The 3 crayons, crayon names used and your name must be displayed with the wall hanging. Use a small plastic bag and index card for this purpose.

Please don't stress - have FUN selecting the fabrics that reflect your crayon colors, and then have FUN designing and making the wall hanging.
