275 South - Exit 224 Palmetto / Ellenton

At the bottom of the ramp, turn Left on US Highway 301 going East

- ◆ Mosquitoes are occasionally a problem, so bring a can of bug repellent if you have one on hand.
- ◆ If you like a particular drink, bring it along.
